FREE Physical Therapy Services

Get the quality healthcare you need, while helping Doctorate of Physical Therapy (DPT) Students learn first hand from invaluable experiences of patient interaction, assessment, and treatment.

WHAT:

- **Free physical therapy** service provided by Student Physical Therapists under the supervision of licensed Physical Therapists.

WHO:

- **Available to anyone** seeking treatment
- **No referral necessary** (for the first 30 days)
- **No appointment necessary**, though slots fill up fast

HOW:

- The DPT EAC is strictly non-profit
- UF faculty, local clinicians and DPT students volunteer their time
- The clinic is funded by a 5K "Race for Rehab" organized by the DPT students

WHY:

- We, the students, strive to provide high quality, pro-bono physical therapy care as we learn and give back to our community.

WHEN:

- **Every Thursday night** (except UF holidays)
- **6-8pm** (please arrive by 7pm to guarantee your spot)
- We will be open every Thursday through the end of November except 11/23 (Thanksgiving). We will be closed in December and will re-open 1/11/18.
